OCQG Board Meeting will be held via Zoom on Monday, June 1, 7pm

We will hold a Board Meeting via Zoom on Monday, June 1, at 7 pm to consider what steps the Guild needs to take to fulfill obligations outlined in our bylaws given the Guild's current inability to meet in person.

Most important, the bylaws specify that the membership will vote to approve a slate of officers for 2020-2021 at the June Guild meeting, but since that in-person meeting has been cancelled, we need to find an alternative process. We will also discuss other ways to serve the membership and keep everyone engaged and informed until we can meet again in person. We welcome any ideas you might have.

The Board is composed of the President, Past President (non-voting), Secretary, Treasurer, and a representative from each standing committee: Program, Service, Membership, Historian, Newsletter, Library, and Technology.

We will send an email invitation with instructions on how to join the Zoom meeting later this month to everyone listed in the Board roster on page 7. Everyone is welcome to participate, but each committee must select one of their members to cast a vote on their behalf during the meeting.

FACE MASK UPDATE

This project began during the third week of March 2020. In just 6 weeks, volunteers from the Old Capitol Quilters Guild joined forces with volunteers from The Preemie Project, Days for Girls-lowa City Chapter, and individuals from the community at large to sew **more than 7000 face masks** for hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, and a host of public service and social service agencies and organizations in the greater lowa City area.

We are extremely grateful for the commitment and skills of the many volunteers who achieved so much in so little time, and the agencies and individuals who received these masks are too.

ONGOING NEEDS

There continues to be a need for additional face masks and other PPE throughout the community. More details for specific items and drop off information can be found at https://www.ocqq.org/ongoing-needs.

United Way serves a number of non-profit organizations in need of cloth face masks for their staff and volunteers as they continue to provide services. Any face mask design is appreciated.

VA Medical Center continues to need masks to pass out to non-Covid 19 patients and visitors. Pleated face mask, surgeon skull caps and scrub hats are needed.

Mercy Hospital continues to need both pleated and Olson masks for staff and visitors plus gowns.

Iowa City Transit continues to supply masks for their passengers and general public. Any mask design is appreciated.


